A few Tips to Remember:

- ◇ You must register online for care, and all changes either adding days or deleting days must go through the Minneapolis Kids main office.
- ◇ We do not have access to food other than snacks during non school days. We do not provide breakfast or lunch, You may bring breakfast for your child to eat on site if you want, and you must bring a lunch and a beverage for your child.
- ◇ Our main room is 216, if you are looking for us, this is the first place you should check.
- ◇ If we are going on a field trip we need all children to be at Minneapolis Kids at least 1/2 hour before we are scheduled to get on the bus.

There are many important tasks that we must complete before we get on the bus, and we need to have all kids here so they will know what to expect for the day as well as information and behavior expectations for the bus and the field trip.

- ◇ Do not send money with your child unless it is listed on the field trip calendar.
- ◇ All kids must have a signed field trip permission slip.
- ◇ PLEASE REMEMBER TO CALL OR EMAIL ME IF YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABSENT FROM MINNEAPOLIS KIDS.
- ◇ **Due to Pokémon cards being misplaced, lost, stolen, etc. We are not having them on site unless it is a non-school day.**

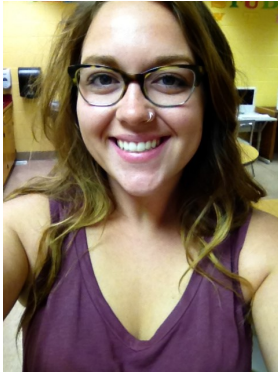
