Thank you for the emails to keep us in the loop about changes to your contract.

Please just note that all of these changes need to be made through our central office.

This is also true for Drop In requests

When your child wants to drop in for care you will need to request that online via your account portal. We are very careful to honor our waitlists and that is why we are so careful about not authorizing drop-in care for families without first looking at our numbers, and staffing.

This holds true for non-school days as well. Drop in care will need to be authorized through the registration office. Families will not be able to request drop in care onsite.
