Minneapolis Kids is closed when Mpls Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather. The district considers closing school when wind chill is —35 or colder at 6:30 am, more than 6 inches of snow falls in 12 hours, or more than 8 inches of snow falls in 24 hours.

They will try to tell families by 6 pm the day before the cancellation or by 5:30 am the day of the cancellation.
