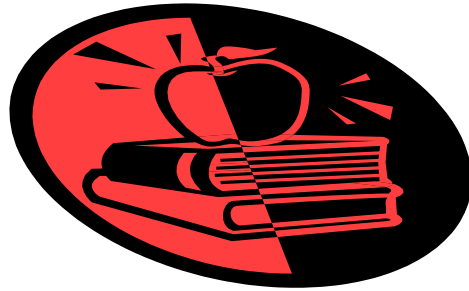

Important Information

- Our hours of operation are from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. A late fee of \$1 per minute is assessed, when children are picked up after 6:00 p.m. Three late pickups result in termination from the program. Please note that the main entrance to our program is door #5 which is on the 49th street side of the school.
- Our program is closed Monday, September 7 in observance of the holiday.
- If medication is prescribed for a child which must be taken during Minneapolis Kids hours, written instructions by a physician or dentist must be provided along with written permission to administer the medicine from the parent. The medication must be in the original container labeled with the child's name along with the dosage amount and frequency. This procedure also applies to "over the counter" medicine including, but not limited to, cough syrup and aspirin.
- Please notify our staff, if your child will be absent on one of their scheduled days. We will contact you, if your child does not arrive as expected.
- Our program successfully completed the Accreditation process through the Minnesota Afterschool Care Association last May. Thanks to all that supported us through the journey.
- Our main office must be notified at least two weeks in advance of any schedule change.
- We are happy to offer a space especially designed for those children enrolled in the fourth through seventh grades. These students will meet in room 32 for activities that have been developed to meet their specific needs.
- Children will spend some time outside, weather permitting. Please send appropriate clothing daily.
- Toys and items of value should remain at home. Other belongings should be labeled with the family's name.
