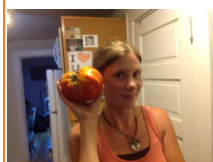

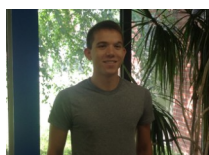

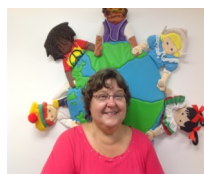

Policy Reminders

Sign In/Out:

Parents or authorized adults MUST sign children in and out daily and make contact with a staff.

Absences:

It is very helpful to call the site if your child will not be coming to Mpls. Kids that day. This is especially important after school. If you want to change your child's schedule you must let the main office know two weeks in advance so as to not be charged for days you cancel.

Late Pick Up:

Mpls. Kids closes at 6:00 PM. There is a \$1 per minute fee charged for any pick up after 6 (according

Release of Children:

If someone other than a legal guardian is picking up your Child please let the staff know. They will need to show a photo ID when signing children out.

Toys From Home:

Please do not bring toys home to Mpls. Kids. Toys may be damaged or lost. It is best to keep them at home!

Peanut Free:

We have a peanut free room. We ask that children do not bring peanut products into our room and if your child consumed a peanut product before school please be sure that they have washed their hands thoroughly
