Lights On Afterschool

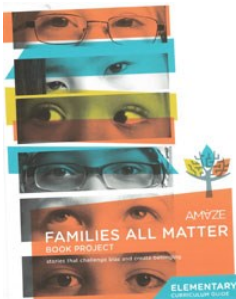
